














# Track and trail classification

Walking track descriptions		
	<b>Grade 1</b>	Flat, well formed track, no steps, 5km or less. Clearly signposted. Suitable for wheelchairs with assistance.
	<b>Grade 2</b>	Formed track. May have gentle hills and some steps. Clearly signposted. No experience required.
	<b>Grade 3</b>	Formed track, some obstacles, 20 km or less. May have short steep hills and many steps. Some experience recommended.
	<b>Grade 4</b>	Rough track. May be long and very steep with few directional signs. For experienced bushwalkers.
	<b>Grade 5</b>	Unformed track. Likely to be very rough, very steep and unmarked. For very experienced bushwalkers with specialised skills.

Mountain-bike trail descriptions		
	<b>Very easy</b>	Wide trail, gentle gradient, no obstacles. For beginner cyclists with basic bike skills.
	<b>Easy</b>	Wide trail, gentle gradient, some obstacles. For beginner mountain bikers with basic mountain-bike skills.
	<b>Intermediate</b>	Moderate gradient, obstacles and some steep sections. For skilled mountain bikers.
	<b>Difficult</b>	For experienced mountain bikers. Challenging trail. Large, unavoidable obstacles and features. Long steep climbs or descents and loose surfaces.
	<b>Extreme</b>	For highly experienced mountain bikers. All sections extremely challenging. Large, unavoidable obstacles and severe features.

Horse trail descriptions		
	<b>Class 1 Easy</b>	Wide trail, natural, surface, gentle slope. For novice riders and experienced horses with basic skills and fitness.
	<b>Class 2 Intermediate</b>	Variable trail, moderate slope, some obstacles. For experienced riders and horses with moderate skills and fitness.
	<b>Class 3 Advanced</b>	Challenging trail, variable surface, many obstacles and steep sections. For advanced riders and horses with high skill and fitness level.
