Chief Executive Declaration Prescribed Commercial Activity

Natural Bridge section of Springbrook National Park

COMMENCEMENT DATE 1ST December, 2011

Please be advised that the conduct of evening glow-worm commercial tour operations within the Natural Bridge TIPA Location (see below Plan) are hereby declared a prescribed commercial activity under the *Recreation Areas Management Act 2006, section 97; Nature Conservation (Protected Areas Management) Regulation 2006, section 77.*

From the 5th December, 2011, evening commercial glow-worm tour operations may only be conducted within the Natural Bridge section of Springbrook National Park (Natural Bridge TIPA Location) under a Commercial Activity Agreement; or for the remainder of the term of a current commercial activity permit.

The Chief Executive will only enter into Commercial Activity Agreements with commercial tour operators who held a commercial activity permit prior to the commencement date; or who are successful as part of a future Expression Of Interest.
