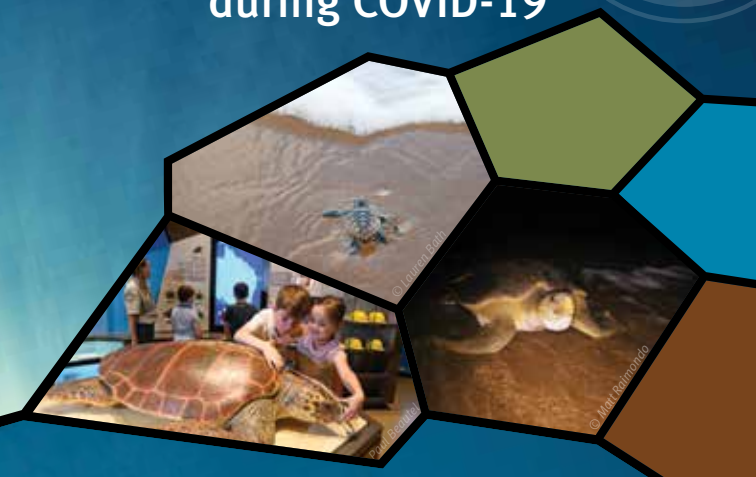


# Mon Repos Turtle Centre during COVID-19



The Mon Repos Turtle Centre is dedicated to marine turtle research, protection and education. Discover the details, the big picture and the people protecting these ancient mariners.

The centre offers a year-round experience with displays, immersive theatre room, information desk and gift shop. In the conservation park you will find outdoor trails and access to the beach.

As part of our COVID-safe plan, visitor numbers are limited within the centre and some interactive displays are closed. ## Hatchling Hall

## Turtle Tales

Self-guided immersive experiences in the Centre, where you can explore the displays and learn about Mon Repos in the theatre.

7 days-a-week. Closed 25 December and 25 April.

**Entry to Turtle Tales must be pre-booked and paid online.**

## Turtle Encounters

Ranger-guided turtle tours on Mon Repos beach. 7 nights-a-week during turtle tour season from November to late March (closed 24, 25 and 31 December). **Bookings are essential as numbers are limited to 14 people/group.** Please visit our webpage for booking details.
