

Restricted access area

Unauthorised entry prohibited



Entry to Low Lake (Rarda-Ndolphin) in Rinyirru (Lakefield) National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) (see map) is restricted to protect significant cultural resources.

A person, other than an acknowledged member of the Awu-Laya or Lama Lama Aboriginal people, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from the Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS).

The restriction enables the Awu-Laya and Lama Lama Aboriginal people to cooperatively protect and manage the area. This is a joint initiative between the Awu-Laya and Lama Lama people and QPWS.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply.
