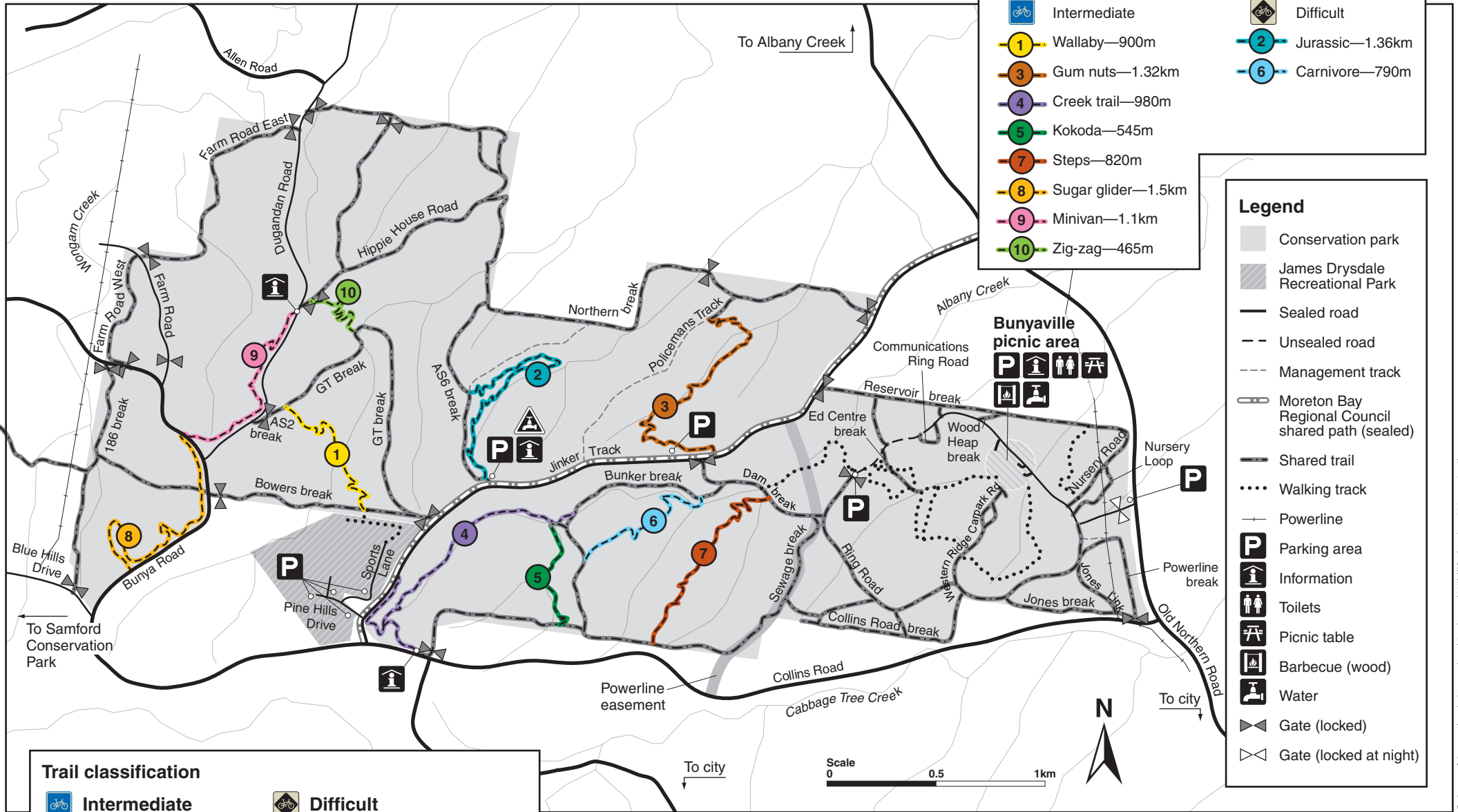


# Bunyaville Conservation Park map
