
## **Regulatory notice** Activities prohibited


For public safety and protection of natural and cultural resources on Lady Musgrave Island and in the lagoon, the following activities are prohibited—

- Operating a vessel at planing speed or at a speed that could reasonably be expected to strike a turtle, in the Go Slow Area (maximum penalty—20 penalty units)
- Anchoring in the No Anchoring Area (maximum penalty—20 penalty units)
- Anchoring in the access channel (maximum penalty—20 penalty units)
- Swimming or snorkelling in the access channel (maximum penalty—50 penalty units)
- Lighting a fire on the island, beach or in the lagoon (maximum penalty—165 penalty units)

**MAP 1** shows limits of No Anchoring Area and Go Slow Area **MAP 2** shows limits of the access channel.

Contravention of the requirements of this regulatory notice is an offence against the Marine Parks Act 2004 and Nature Conservation Act 1992.









Visitors are reminded that domestic animals are not permitted on the island or beach.
