

Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised Entry Prohibited

Protection of cultural resources

Entry to this island, Ronganhu Island, Marpa National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) (see map) is restricted to protect significant cultural resources.

The restriction enables the Lama Lama Traditional Owners and Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) to protect and manage the cultural values of the area.

A person, other than an acknowledged Lama Lama Traditional Owner, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from QPWS.
