Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised Entry Prohibited Protection of cultural resources

Entry to Muhr-Amalee, Hinchinbrook Island National Park (see map) is restricted to protect significant cultural resources.

This site, on the western side of Missionary Bay, is bounded by headlands 600 m east and 800 m west of this sign, and extends inland (south) from the beach to a maximum distance of 1.2 km.

A person, other than an acknowledged Traditional Owner, as identified by the Girringun Aboriginal Corporation, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service.
