To protect nesting seabirds and sensitive pisonia forest, entry to this island—Rocky Islet (a), Three Islands Group National Park (see map)—is prohibited without a permit or written approval.


Nesting birds are easily alarmed and will leave their nests if disturbed. Eggs and chicks are then vulnerable to heat, cold and predators and can die quickly.
