

Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Protection of cultural resources

Entry to Olilu Island, Marpa National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) is restricted to protect cultural resources.

The restriction enables Lama Lama Traditional Owners and the Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) to protect and manage the cultural values of the area.

A person, other than an acknowledged Lama Lama Traditional Owner, must not enter or remain in the restricted area shown on the map without a permit or written approval from QPWS.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units
