

Restricted Access Area

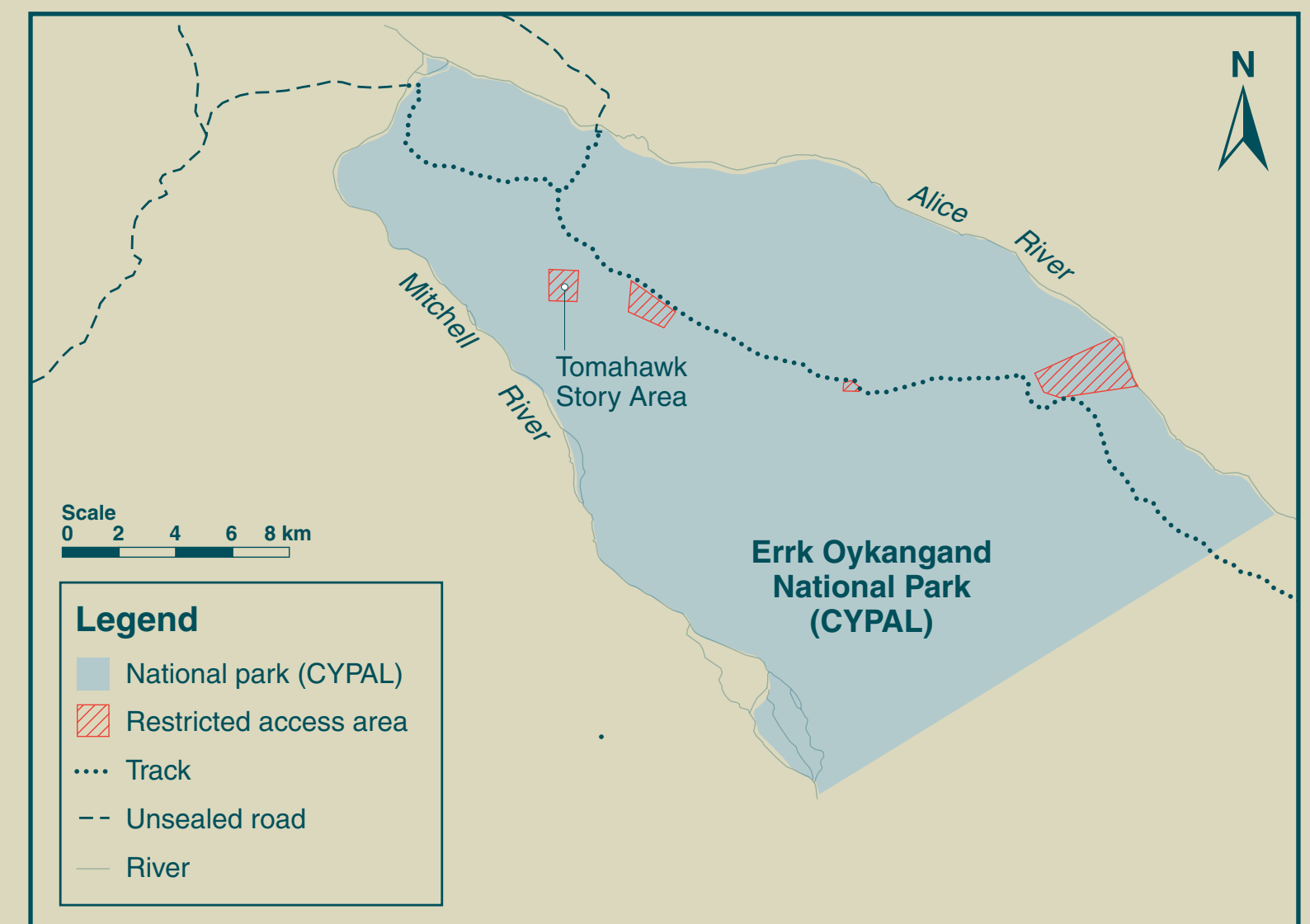
Unauthorised Entry Prohibited

Protection of cultural resources

Entry to the Tomahawk Story Area, Errk Oygangand National Park (Cape York Peninsula Aboriginal Land) (see map) is restricted to protect significant cultural resources.

The restriction enables the Uw Oygangand people and Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) to protect and manage the cultural values of the area.

A person, other than an acknowledged Uw Oygangand person, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from the Errk Oygangand National Park Land Trust. For further information, phone (07) 4083 7154.
