## No vehicle access



Vehicle use on all tidal lands, including beaches, beyond this point is prohibited.

This will help protect mangrove fish habitats, dune vegetation to assist the rebuild of Sandy Point and essential bird habitat for vulnerable species.

Contravention of a requirement of a regulatory notice is an offence under the Marine Parks Act 2004.

Maximum penalty: 20 penalty units.

On-the-spot fines apply.



## Regulatory notice

## Vehicles permitted on bare sand only

Driving or parking vehicles on any vegetation—mangroves, grass, trees and tree roots—at Sandy Point and any tidal areas adjoining Byfield National Park is prohibited.

Preferably use the car park.

Your assistance is needed to protect plants to help rebuild Sandy Point.

Contravention of a requirement of a regulatory notice is an offence under the *Marine Parks Act 2004*.

Maximum penalty: 20 penalty units.

On-the-spot fines apply.
