

Restricted access area – Rattlesnake Point

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Entry to Rattlesnake Point (*Marbaymba*) in Cedar Bay National Park is restricted to protect significant cultural resources (see map).



The restriction enables Eastern Kuku Yalanji people to protect and manage the cultural features and attributes of the area. This is a joint initiative between the Eastern Kuku Yalanji people and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

A person, other than an acknowledged member of the Eastern Kuku Yalanji, must not enter or remain in this area without a permit or written approval from the EPA.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units.

On-the-spot fines may apply.
