

Restricted Access Area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Natural resource protection

A restricted access area has been declared over the Coomera Gorge area, as shown on the map, to protect rare and threatened species and critical, sensitive habitat.

Entry to the area—including climbing, abseiling and all cliff and rope-based activities—is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

- The gorge and waterfall area are habitat for endangered, vulnerable and near-threatened plant species.

Contravention of the requirements of this notice is an offence against the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply.
