

Restricted access area

Unauthorised entry prohibited

Public safety and cultural heritage protection



Rock slopes and cliffs are unstable and serious injury or death could result from climbing them. Visitors must remain on the formed track. A restricted access area has been declared from the eastern edge of the car park to Mickey Creek, as shown on this map.

Entry to the restricted access area is prohibited without a permit or written approval.

Contravention of a requirement of this notice is an offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992*.

Maximum penalty: 80 penalty units. On-the-spot fines apply.

It is a serious offence under the *Nature Conservation Act 1992* to interfere with a cultural resource such as Aboriginal rock art in a protected area.

Maximum penalty: 3000 penalty units.
